

CISA Revision Weekend Workshop 2005

The London Chapter is pleased to offer our popular **CISA Revision Weekend Workshop**. This will be held on 14th and 15th May 2005 at Theobalds Park, Cheshunt, Hertfordshire, which is just north of J.25 (A10) on the M25.

A maximum of 24 delegates can be accommodated. There is certain to be a large demand so please book your place early to guarantee your place.

The Workshop leader will be John Mitchell, who is currently Academic Relations Director of the Chapter. John is a very experienced trainer and has run a number of CISA workshops for the London Chapter and other Chapters throughout Europe.

The CISA Revision Weekend Workshop

The workshop is a separate chargeable event and is complementary to the individual CISA Training Days. Its aim is to enable a delegate to identify any particular weaknesses in time to allow remedial action before the CISA exam. **Therefore, delegates are expected to be familiar with the content of the CISA domains.**

This weekend provides an excellent opportunity to clarify the thought processes when working under pressure. The format is primarily a reminder of the task and knowledge requirements for each CISA domain, followed by a mock examination with a discussion on the 'correct' answer to each question. Some time is also allocated for examining the structure of a CISA question and discussing a generic approach to help identify the appropriate answer. This not only hones the delegates' examination technique, but also provides for lively discussion.

The actual CISA examination is scheduled for Saturday 11th June 2005, so delegates will have a full month to review any weaknesses identified during the workshop. CISA Review Workshop attendees consistently achieve a higher pass rate than non attendees.

The workshop can be booked either with or without accommodation, but please note that the venue is only accessible by car/taxi. Dinner and breakfast is included if you choose the accommodation option. Please complete the registration form over the page.
